



The Links at Union Vale to Host the 2025 Hudson Valley Cup

It's that time of year again!! The HVGCSA's premiere fundraising event will be held on Tuesday, June 17th at the Links at Union Vale in Lagrangeville, NY. The Hudson Valley Cup is enjoying its 34th year as a charity tournament to raise money for scholarships and turfgrass research. This tournament was the brainchild of long time HVGCSA member Dan Madar and it's still going strong. Our host, Chris Strehl, is looking forward to hosting this event and is hoping for a big turnout. For those of you that haven't had the pleasure of playing "The Links", you will love it. It's a perfect course for a scramble format because it is so long and difficult.

The Links at Union Vale

Our meeting site on the 14th was once a farm owned by the late Karl Ehmer, the "King of Quality Meats". Upon Karl's death, the farm was purchased by the Irish Golf Association (IGA) in the mid-nineties with the aim of building a quality "links style' course on the property. Construction began in 1998 under the watchful eye of the Burton F. Clark Company. The course opened for play in June of 2000. It's not an easy layout to score on, playing some 6,900 yards from the championship tees. Ninety-seven bunkers dot the course with beautiful native areas framing the distinctive rolling fairways. There is not a lot of primary rough and the wind blows all the time. There are some very challenging holes to conquer. The 15th is a 460-yard par-four with out-of-bounds left and #14 is a monster parfive measuring 603 yards in length. It's going to be a fun scramble!!

"Links" Superintendent Chris Strehl began his career as an intern in 1991 at Ridgewood CC after graduating with a bachelor's degree in Plant Science from SUNY Cobleskill. In 1992, Chris left to work at Orange County CC for another Walsh alumnus, Tim Garceau. When

Tim moved on to the Tuxedo Club, Chris followed to serve as his first assistant.

In 1998 Chris was hired by the IGA to grow in "The Links". 2025 marks Chris's 27th year at the golf course. Despite the challenges of a tight budget, Chris manages to keep "The Links" in great shape. Notwithstanding having a small crew to care for this huge property, Chris carries on with a fearsome determination. That's just the way Chris rolls, he keeps plugging away and moving forward. No excuses!!

And I have to say one other thing. Chris was a "beekeeper" way before it was popular. Chris has always maintained hives at the property. He used to have one in his office which was very interesting to study. So, don't forget, Chris was the OG of beekeeping in the Hudson Valley.

The best thing that ever happened in Chris' life is his soulmate Debbie. Debbie and Chris tied the knot in 2004. Together they have built quite a life. The Strehl clan reside at the course along with River and Brooke, the family dogs.


